

PRIVACY STATEMENT

This Privacy Statement relates solely to the online information collection and use practices of our Web site located at <http://www.blueknightseminars.com/> (this “Web Site”), and not to any subdomains of this Web Site. We at Blue Knight Battlefield Seminars recognize that many visitors and users of this Web Site are concerned about the information they provide to us, and how we treat that information. We value your privacy. This Privacy Statement, which may be updated from time to time, has been developed to address those concerns.

WHAT INFORMATION ABOUT YOU DO WE COLLECT?

When you visit our Web Site, you may provide us with two types of information: (1) personally identifiable information that you specifically choose to disclose, which is collected on an individual basis, and (2) general user information that does not contain personally identifiable information, which is collected on an aggregate basis as you browse the Web Site. In some cases, if you choose not to provide the specifically requested information, you may not be able to access all of this Web Site’s content or services.

Personally Identifiable Information You Choose to Provide.

This Web Site may ask for certain personal information from you for the purpose of providing to you content and/or services that you request. For example, if you indicate an interest in receiving promotional information about Blue Knight Battlefield Seminars, you are asked to submit your name and e-mail address, which we retain on file, so that we may send you the information that you requested. We collect financial information (like an account or credit card numbers) only from visitors making a credit card or other purchase. We use the financial information solely to bill the user for services and/or products, and necessary information from the order form to process orders. We also request your name and e-mail address each time you contact us by clicking on the “Contact Us” link. We may retain a record of users who have contacted us in order to respond properly to questions or concerns and for purposes of future communications.

Non-Personally Identifiable Information We Collect.

Cookies/Web server logs: Similar to other Web sites, this Web Site utilizes standard technology called generally referred to as “cookies” and Web server logs to collect information about how this Web Site is used. Cookies are a feature of Web browser software that allows Web servers to recognize the computer used to access a Web site. Cookies are small pieces of data that are stored by a user’s Web browser on the user’s

hard drive. Information gathered through cookies and Web server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our Web Site, and the Web sites visited just before and just after our Web Site. This information is collected on an aggregate basis. None of this information is associated with you as an individual.

You can disable cookies on your computer by indicating this in the preferences or options menus in your browser. However, it is possible that some parts of this Web Site will not operate correctly if you disable cookies. You should consult with your browser's provider/manufacture if you have any questions regarding disabling cookies.

HOW DO WE USE THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT?

We use your personally identifiable information to provide you with the information, content or services that you have requested, and in some cases to contact you about our programs, features or services. If you no longer wish to receive notices, bulletins or any other type of information from us, you may send us an email through our "Contact Us" link to change your preferences.

We use non-identifying information collected on this Web Site in the aggregate to better understand your use of the Web Site and to enhance your overall enjoyment and experience in using our Web Site. For example, we may use the information to improve the design, format or content of our Web Site, or to analyze and improve the programs and services that we offer.

We may employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf. Our employees, agents and independent contractors who have access to personally identifiable information are required to protect the information in a manner that is consistent with our Privacy Statement.

We may provide access to your personally identifiable information when we are legally required to do so, to cooperate with police investigations or other legal proceedings, to protect against misuse or unauthorized use of our Web Site, to limit our legal liability and protect our rights, or to protect the rights and safety of visitors to this Web Site or the public. In such instances, the information is provided only for the specific limited purpose.

We will not share your personally identifiable information in ways unrelated to those described above without providing you with an opportunity to opt out of such use or otherwise prohibit such unrelated uses.

HOW DO YOU ACCESS OR MODIFY YOUR INFORMATION OR CHOICES?

If you visit our Web Site and volunteer personally identifiable information, you may modify, update or delete such information at any time by sending us an e-mail through the “Contact Us” link on this Web Site. You should be aware, however, that it is not always possible to completely remove or modify information in our databases. In addition, please be aware that your ability to opt out from receiving notices, bulletins or any other promotional materials from us does not change our right to contact you regarding your use of our Web Site.

CHILDREN’S GUIDELINES

Children’s privacy is also important to us.
